



FIRST-YEAR CURRICULUM PILOT

OBJECTIVE

To evaluate Faith Freedom Life*'s 12 Steps to Inner Healing program and the implementation of the "Support Group Participant Workbook," which integrates scripture, meditation, and reflection tools, through pre- and post-surveys conducted during the first-year curriculum pilot.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Faith Freedom Life* (FFL) is a holistic program that supports families and returning citizens before, during, and after incarceration. By addressing social, spiritual, and interpersonal needs, FFL helps participants rediscover hope and develop thriving relationships within their families and communities.

Our programming empowers individuals to transform their perspectives and break free from destructive cycles. Through tailored group sessions, participants receive the tools to foster emotional healing, spiritual growth, and interpersonal connection.

To offer community and connections to inspire hope and facilitate transformation in the lives of families of the incarcerated.

VISION


A world where those impacted by incarceration experience holistic healing and empowerment, breaking the cycle of recidivism.
